

English

We will look at traditional stories and stories with familiar settings. We will be looking at non-fiction texts and learn the key features of information texts.

Maths

Read and write numbers up to 100. Count up to 100 objects by grouping in tens, fives, twos or threes. Recall multiplication facts for 5, 2, 3 and 10 times tables. Children will be expected to partition a two digit number into tens and units.

Science

The children will observe and describe seasonal changes. Looking at why the trees lose their leaves in Autumn, recording temperature changes, looking at animals that hibernate and seasonal fruit and vegetables.
