Year 3 Autumn Term 1 – There's no place like home! 'All about Rawtenstall.'

English Folk tales and biographies

Children will listen to and discuss and wide range of folk tales such as Grimm's Fairy Tales. They will sequence the main events and discuss the themes. They will read and analyse stories in order to plan and write their own versions.

Maths Place value and number

Children will read, write and order whole numbers to at least 1000. They will derive and recall addition and subtraction facts for each number to 20, sums and differences of multiples of 10 & number pairs that total 100. Children will apply their place value knowledge to written methods of addition and subtraction.

Art Observational drawings

We will develop our drawing skills and experiment with different grades of pencils. We will make accurate sketchings of buildings and landscapes. We will sketch using fine lines and detail. We will learn about shades of colours.
