

Take more notice of punctuation.					
Cross – check all sources of information while reading.					
Note familiar words and letter clusters and use these to get to unknown words, e.g. look – took.					
Predict in more detail					
Search for information in print to predict, confirm or attempt new words while reading.					
Notice relationships between one text and another.

Offer and discuss interpretations of text.					

- Widening range of genre and writing style.
- Story line or theme may be sustained over a longer period of time.
- Characters may be more fully developed.
- More than one point of view expressed within the text.
- Information or action may be implied rather than spelled out.
- Texts may contain more metaphorical or technical lang.
- Non fiction texts placed in a broader context and include more detailed information.
